Requirements:

- information gleaned from (at least) 5 reliable sources, printed out or copied, to be submitted in a manila folder or stapled to the teacher on the day of the presentation
- Works Cited page, written in MLA format
- 7-10 minute oral presentation (only note cards allowed when presenting)
- photos and/or visuals, including map
- creativity
